
WARN Act Layoffs

The Wuhan Virus has had a devastating impact on employment in Ohio. There were **55,305 jobs lost** to mass layoffs in 2020, making it the single-worst year for mass layoffs since 1997. In fact, 2020 had three times as many mass layoffs as the total for 2021–2023.

Wuhan Virus Caused Record Mass Layoffs in Ohio


MONTHLY MASS LAYOFF NOTICES SINCE 1997

2020 Worst Year for Mass Layoffs in Ohio


